

PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED PART OF A MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AND EXECUTIVE BOARD COMMISSIONING SUB-COMMITTEE TO BE HELD IN PRIVATE

Under Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, a decision made by a decision-making body to hold a meeting in private is a prescribed decision for the purpose of section 9GA(5) of the 2000 Act (regulations requiring prescribed information about prescribed decisions). At least 28 clear days before a private meeting, the decision making body must make available at the offices of the relevant local authority a notice of its intention to hold the meeting in private and publish that notice on the relevant local authority's website, if it has one.

<u>In addition</u> to the above, at least five clear days before a private meeting, the decision-making body must make available at the offices of the relevant local authority a further notice of its intention to hold the meeting in private and publish that notice on the relevant local authority's website, if it has one.

1. Part of the meeting of the **Executive Board on 18 December 2012** will be held in private for the following reason:

Items on the agenda for the above meeting will contain exempt information under paragraph 5 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972.

2. Part of the meeting of the <u>Executive Board Commissioning Sub Committee on 18</u> <u>December 2012</u> will be held in private for the following reason:

Items on the agenda for the above meeting will contain exempt information under paragraph 3 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972.

No representations have been received by the decision making body about why the meeting should be open to the public.
