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#### 1. BACKGROUND

As part of the revised Governance arrangements the Authority has delegated key responsibilities for policy and strategy to the Policy and Strategy Committee. As part of those delegated responsibilities, the Chair of the Policy and Strategy Committee and the Management lead report to the Authority on its business and actions as agreed at Fire and Rescue Authority meeting on 1 June 2007.

#### 2. REPORT

- 2.1 The minutes of the Policy and Strategy Committee meeting of Friday 01 April 2011 are attached to this report at Appendix A. The following summarises the main points of the papers discussed at the meeting.
- 2.2 Consideration was given to a report regarding the Fire and Rescue Services Act 2004, Section 13 and 16 Agreements, and an update provided by the Chief Fire Officer further to a request made at the February 2011 meeting of the Committee. It was resolved that the report be noted and that the Chief Fire Officer be required to submit a further report to the Policy and Strategy Committee with regard to the implications of cross border working and the potential charging arrangements being extended to all neighbouring Fire and Rescue Services.
- 2.3 A further report presented to Members the proposals to introduce a Community Right to Challenge. It was resolved that in addition to the report being noted, the Chief Fire Officer prepare a response for the Fire and Rescue Authority which should be circulated to all members of this Committee for comment before despatch to Communities and Local Government.
- 2.4 The Committee were asked to consider exclusion of the public in accordance with Section 100A(4) of the Local Government Act 1972 for the remaining report. This was endorsed and the Committee went on to consider a report regarding joint ICT provision.

## 31 FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICES ACT 2004, SECTION 13 AND 16 AGREEMENTS - 2010 UPDATE

Further to minute 23 dated 4 February 2011, consideration was given to a report of the Chief Fire Officer, copies of which had been circulated, regarding the provision of mutual assistance with neighbouring Fire and Rescue Services.

RESOLVED that the report be noted and that the Chief Fire Officer be required to submit a further report to the Policy and Strategy Committee with regard to the implications of cross border working and the potential charging arrangements being extended to all neighbouring Fire and Rescue Services.

#### 32 PROPOSALS TO INTRODUCE A COMMUNITY RIGHT TO CHALLENGE

Consideration was given to a report of the Chief Fire Officer, copies of which had been circulated, informing the Committee of the current Government consultation on the Community Right to Challenge.

Whilst Councillors valued transparent processes and accountability, concern was expressed with regard to the potential impact on administration recourses required to respond to a community challenge when the Authority systematically consulted the community on the Risk Management Plan and that this was an opportunity to comment on and challenge proposals prior to their application.

- (2) that the Chief Fire Officer prepare a response for the Fire and Rescue Authority which should be circulated to all members of this Committee for comment before despatch to Communities and Local Government.
