Purpose of Report:

This report notifies membership of the Authority following the Annual Meetings of the County and City Councils, requests nominations to committees and boards and seeks confirmation of dates of meetings. It also seeks to appoint chairs of committees from those appointed to serve on them.

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1. BACKGROUND

The Authority has continued to deliver its wider community safety agenda through the committee structure. At the Annual General Meeting the Authority is required to resolve what committees shall be appointed and the number of voting members. It is also suggested that the chairs of committees should be appointed at the Annual General Meeting in order to ensure continuity of business.

The position with regard to the Standards Committee is that this needs to remain in place for as long as the current determination regime exists. Provisions in the Localism Act 2011 provide for the introduction of new standards arrangements which the Government have indicated will not come into force until 1 July 2012.

2.3 Committee Membership

- 2.3.1 The Authority is asked to appoint members to the Committees set out in the table below, where applicable, in accordance with the political balance rules and, from those appointments, to appoint the chair of each committee. In order to assist members the appointments in place at the end of 2011/12 are set out in Appendix A to this report.
- 2.3.2 In order to ensure that the Standards Committee is viewed as 'non political' the current terms of reference provide for a membership comprising of one member from each of the Conservative, Labour and Liberal Democrat groups,

one other elected member and two independent non elected members. Given the current make up of the Authority it is suggested that the other elected member should be the Independent member.

- 2.3.3 Although the Standards Committee currently has no requirement for political balance there is a legal requirement under the present arrangements that an independent non elected member must be appointed chair. The current independent chair is Beverley Denby, who it is recommended should be reappointed chair pending the implementation of the new arrangements. The other independent member is Alan Street who was appointed for a 4 year term which commenced on 18 December 2012. Both appointments will need to be reviewed in the run up to the implementation of new arrangements which will be the subject of a separate report.
- 2.3.4 In addition to the committee appointments, the Authority is asked to appoint members to the Strategic Equalities Board on the basis of 2 Labour Group places, 2 Conservative Group places and 1 Liberal Democrat Group place and to confirm the membership of the Best Value Review Board as the Chair and Vice Chair of the Fire and Rescue Authority with other members appointed by invitation depending on the best value review being undertaken.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The City Council provides the Clerk and Monitoring Officer for all meetings of the Fire and Rescue Authority, Policy and Strategy Committee, Standards Committee, Personnel Committee and Appointments Committee. It also makes provision for a Constitutional Services Officer to be present for all committee meetings identified in 2.4 above, for which agendas and minutes will be circulated by the Clerk. For 2012/13 the cost to Nottinghamshire and City of Nottingham Fire and Rescue Authority for these services will be £37,000 plus VAT. Any additional services and printing costs will be recharged separately.
- 3.2 An independent remuneration committee established the allowances to be paid to Fire and Rescue Authority Members and this also provided for these to be up rated annually in accordance with Local Government pay awards. The payment of Members' Allowances under the Scheme was re-approved by the Authority at its meeting on 24 February 2012.
