## 33 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

The Chair welcomed Councillor Cross back to the Fire Authority after his absence due to illness.

Apologies for absence were received from Councillor Hempsall and Councillor Spencer.

#### 34 DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS

No declarations of interests were made.

#### 35 MINUTES

RESOLVED that the minutes of the meeting held on 21 September 2012, copies of which had been circulated, be confirmed and signed by the Chair.

## 36 CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Chair reported on the following matters:

- (a) the Chair had attended the Service's Annual Awards Presentation Ceremony in November at Service Headquarters. It had been attended by the new Lord Lieutenant of Nottinghamshire, Sir John Peace;
- (b) the Chair and the Chief Fire Officer had attended a meeting in London with Brandon Lewis, the new Fire Minister to discuss current issues. The Chair pointed out the importance of building a relationship with the Minister and maintaining a dialogue in order to get messages across;
- (c) It had been announced that the preferred bidder for the Fire Service College in Gloucester was Capita.

#### 37 CHANCELLORS AUTUMN STATEMENT

This item was withdrawn from the agenda as no additional information was available to members other than that reported in the Press.

#### 38 UPDATE ON PROGRESS WITH TRI-SERVICE CONTROL

Consideration was given to a report of the Chief Fire Officer, copies of which had been circulated, presenting members with an update on the progress with the Tri-Service Control Programme in collaboration with Derbyshire Fire and Rescue Authority and Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland Combined Fire Authority.

The Chief Fire Officer introduced the report, advising the meeting that the Authority together with Derbyshire Fire and Rescue Authority and Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland Combined Fire Authority had each committed £246,667 on top of the Government grant of £5.4 million, totalling £6.1 million.

The legal documentation had been signed off and the Tri-Service Control Programme was up and running and the intention was to go out to tender shortly.

Members requested that the Chief Fire Officer keep them informed on the tender process and the provision of the technology required to support the Programme.

RESOLVED that the content of the report be noted and that members continue to support the approach to delivering the programme and the efficiencies it should provide.
