REPORT OF ACTING CORPORATE DIRECTOR OF RESOURCES

APPOINTMENTS TO COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS

1 <u>SUMMARY</u>

- 1.1 The Executive Board at its meeting held on 17 July 2007, delegated to Area Committees the decision as to whether and whom to appoint to their local community associations. The relevant local community associations for West Area are Beechdale Community Association Management Committee, Sheila Russell Community Association Management Committee and the Vale Community Association Management Committee.
- 1.2 The appendix to this report details the twenty different community associations across the City and sets out the function of the Committee, the number of representatives required, whether the representatives must be Councillor's and the frequency of the meetings. This is not an exhaustive list of community associations across the city, it only includes those associations that have, in the past, requested formal representation from the City Council.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

it is recommended that the Area Committee determines whether and whom appoint to the following local Community Associations:-

- (i) Beechdale Community Association Management Committee (one representative can be non-Councillor);
- (ii) Sheila Russell Community Association Management Committee (one representative can be non-Councillor);
- (iii) Vale Community Association Management Committee (one representative must be a Councillor).

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 Appointments to Outside Bodies (organisations that are external to Nottingham City Council), is a function exercised by the Executive Board. The Board reviews the appointments annually and when last considered on 17 July 2007, it resolved that in relation to local community associations the decisions as to whether and whom to appoint should be delegated to the local Area Committee. Except where changes are required through resignations or changes to the organisations themselves, or where the body specifies a different term of office, these appointments run for the life of the Council (four years).
- 3.2 The Overview and Scrutiny Committee, following a Task and Finish Panel review of partnership working recommended the rationalisation of the Council's representation on outside bodies with the intention of prioritising time and resources more appropriately, ensuring that members have the capacity to

properly represent the Council upon these bodies to which they have been appointed and to ensure that there is a clear link between the purposes of the organisation and the Council.

- 3.3 Clearly when appointments were considered by Executive Board there were some to which appointments were essential or desirable, either because of their statutory basis, because of the requirements of company articles, because they are organisations established by the authority or partnerships with whom we are engaged or to which we subscribe, or because they are otherwise important to the City generally or to a local community. In the case of these Local Community Associations the decision as to whether to appoint to them was delegated to the relevant Area Committee.
- 3.4 All appointments or decisions not to reappoint will be notified to the relevant organisations and individuals concerned as soon as approved by this Committee. Should we be notified, or subsequently become aware that any of the organisations relevant to this Area have ceased to meet, we would notify the relevant Neighbourhood Management Team and individuals concerned.
