free or grant aided energy efficiency


measures to all private sector

Warm Zones Today

- Initially 5 pathfinder
 Zones (2 now Complete)
- Currently 9 Zones and 3 'associated projects'
- Engaged with 33 Local Authorities





Warm Zone Achievements

(as at 31st March 2007)

Total homes in Zones: >1 million

Assessed homes: >500,000

• CERT measures: >£12 million (46,000 homes)

Warm Front measures: >£15 million

Income maximisation: £1,800/ year average uplift

Currently helping to sustain 150 new jobs

- Not for profit ethos






Nottingham Warm Zone the detail....

Nottingham Warm Zone will meet Policy Objectives...

- Alleviation of Fuel Poverty
- Improvements in Energy Efficiency & Decent Homes
- Reduction in Carbon Dioxide (CO₂) emissions
- Reduction in cold related ill health
- Income maximisation
- Local economic and employment gains
- Wider regeneration
- Addressing the impact of rising fuel costs
- Provide accurate baseline data for future policy development on housing and contribute to Nomad and HI4EM





Performance Targets.....

Private sector homes: 83,600

Assessments completed: 59,000

• CERT funded installations: 23,000 (£5.1m)

Warm Front insulation: 11,554 (£2.6m)

Reduction of Carbon Dioxide (LAA N.I 186): 25K tonnes

Improved SAP (LAA N.I. 187):65 SAP (min)

Decent Homes identified & made decent: 1,500

Average benefit uplift £1,700/year
