**29 AREA CAPITAL RESOURCES
(Directors of Regeneration, Planning and Transport and Housing)**

RESOLVED that the following be noted:-

- (1) the total spend of £2.091 million to 31 July 2008, as detailed in Appendix A at the locations in Appendix B to the report;**
- (2) to date 59 footpaths and 42 works to the public realm had been completed;**
- (3) the available funds of £579,000 for the remainder of the programme to the end of March 2009, as detailed in Appendix A to the report;**
- (4) the value of works previously approved for 2007/08 of £536,000, as detailed in Appendix A at the locations in Appendix C to the report;**
- (5) 3 footpaths and 31 public realm works were expected to be completed by 31 March 2009.**
