13 BUDGET UPDATE

Ms Curnow, Area Manager, introduced the report which detailed the latest position regarding West Area schemes funded from Area Committee monies.

During discussion, Councillors raised concerns regarding the length of time between them agreeing to funding requests from their individual budgets and the group concerned receiving the funds.

RESOLVED

- (1) that, with the exception that the Robins Wood Road resurfacing monies be reallocated to the Leen Valley ward budget and not, as stated, to the Aspley ward budget, the reallocation of monies as detailed in appendix 1 be approved;
- (2) that the contribution by local projects to the Local Area Agreement targets, as detailed in paragraph 1.3 of the report, be noted;
- (3) that the allocation of £3,281 to Bilborough Library, for the creation of a 'teenage area', the costs to be met from the Bilborough ward budget, be approved;
- (4) that the Area Manager be requested to:
 - (a) investigate the possibility of submitting a Big Lottery Fund bid to assist with an extension of the Bilborough Boxing Club facilities;
