

The Council's Employment & Skills Portfolio Delivery Plan October 2012/13

To reduce unemployment by 25% by 2015

Unemployment in May 2011, when the target was set was 13,063 (6%), a reduction of 25% gives a target figure of a maximum of 9,797 claimants

Latest Update September 2012 Unemployment has fallen by 0.1% to 6.2% (13,769)

Core Cities Comparison

Nottingham had the largest decrease in unemployment in the last month. Since April unemployment has fallen at the fastest rate of any of the Core Cities



Portfolio Delivery Plan October 2012/13 Key Actions

Nottingham Jobs Fund - 53 people commenced employment since 1st April (82 in total). 36 jobs vacancies currently live at the JCP

Employer Hub' – 200 individuals into employment since 1st April 2012 (including 43 apprenticeships)

2012 Jobs Fairs - 4592 confirmed jobs seekers attended Nottingham Jobs Fair on 25th Sept & 6 Local KNW Community Jobs Fairs completed over the summer



Portfolio Delivery Plan October 2012/13 Key Actions


Innovation Fund - Futures are working with 728 young people at present and 367 have been placed in learning provision and 36 into work

Section 106 - Over 1,000 employment opportunities agreed with developers


Procurement - Inclusion of Employment & Skills questions in tendering process for goods and services over £200K




Local Context – North Locality




