Primary School Place Planning

- City wide growth in population – particular impact on pre-school and primary age pupils.
- West Area – significant growth in numbers that is now outstripping the projections that underpinned 2010 school review.
- “In Year” applications creating significant pressure in the area – i.e. moving into the area during the course of the school year

Places added since 2010

- 105 places at Ambleside – from 525 to 630 places
- 65 places at Robert Shaw Primary – from 355 to 420 places
- All other schools admitting to maximum legal capacity in Key Stage 1

Rosslyn Park Expansion

- Proposals to expand from 450 to 630 places from September 2015.
- Statutory Notice Period (Representation Period) ends 27 November.
- Positive feedback from consultation.
- Current situation - Rosslyn have taken 18 additional Reception in 2012 and a further 18 additional pupils in 2013 ahead of the formal expansion process

Glenbrook Primary

- Glenbrook has been selected for re-build under the Priority School Building Programme.
- This provides the opportunity for additional capacity to be added – site has sufficient space to expand.
- It is envisaged that this will be implemented for the 2015/16 academic year.

Admissions Strategy

- 2014 first admission round soon to commence
- Strong recommendation that applicants:
 1. Apply on time
 2. Include their catchment school
