RESIDENT'S PETITION – IMPROVED CROSSING AT THE RUSSELL DRIVE/TROWELL ROAD JUNCTION

Following an accident last year involving the user of the pedestrian crossing, local people have organised and submitted a petition to the City Council calling for safety improvements to this stretch of road. The petition went before the Council at its meeting on 8th February and will be lodged with the Traffic and Safety service of the Environment and Regeneration Department for attention.

If the responsible service feels it appropriate it may improve the crossing and, hopefully, pedestrian safety. Such improvements might include improved lighting, visual warning signs for motorists and pedestrians alike and physical warning signs to motorists.

If the service declines to take action the Committee could agree to commission its own improvements which would incur costs to the Committee.

The **RECOMMENDATION** to the Committee is that the Neighbourhood Manager enquires into the planned response of the Traffic and Safety service and reports back to this Committee.
