GROUNDWORK

Youth Delivery Targets April – June 14

- **All partners** (9) working with young people have adopted and signed up to common minimum standards
- **9** Youth work **case studies** provided
- **158 unique young people** to have been supported during the quarter through a range of Targeted and Diversionary Activities

Youth Delivery Achievements April – June 14

- **9** partners working with young people have adopted and signed up to common minimum standards
- **9** Youth case studies provided demonstrating work undertaken
- **280 young people** have been **supported** against a target to date of 158
- On average **16** young people's **activities per week** were provided through ABG funding during the quarter
- Approx **500** hours of activities were provided under ABG funding

GROUNDWORK

Changes to ABG July 14 – March 15

- Children & Young People **Funding split proportionally** by ward (Aspley 50%, Bilborough 40% & Leen Valley 10%)
- **Partners** invited to apply for ABG funding by ward, and **must report all outcomes by ward** for performance management purposes
- **Newly identified priorities** form part of grant agreements issued, **all partners must contribute** to these through their work

Priorities are;

- Supporting **healthy relationships**
- **Health** improvement
- Raising **aspiration**
- **Increasing engagement** with schools/colleges/workplaces
- **Increasing** levels of **attainment**
- **Reducing** levels of **offending** and antisocial behaviour

ABG Youth Delivery Targets July 14 – April 15

- **All partners** (8) working with young people have adopted and signed up to common minimum standards
- **All partners** must demonstrate in narrative reports how they are working with other local providers to avoid duplication
- **All partners** must demonstrate in narrative reports how they are working with statutory services
- **24** Further Youth work **case studies** provided
- **185 unique young people** to have been supported through a range of **Targeted** activities (92 Aspley, 74 Bilborough, & 19 Leen Valley)
- **147 unique young people** to have been supported through a range of **Diversiionary** activities (73 Aspley, 59 Bilborough, & 15 Leen Valley)

Additional Contribution to Children & Families Priorities via ABG Funding

July 14 – April 15

- **Employment & Skills** ABG funding was re-focussed 14/15 due to the wealth of other opportunities arising for 18-25 year olds, to now support those aged 50+ & Female Returners to the labour market
- Employment & Skills **Funding split proportionally** by ward (Aspley 50%, Bilborough 40% & Leen Valley 10%)
- **BEST** Leading employment & Skills ABG funded activity

- **25 Female Returners** Supported into employment (12 Aspley, 10 Bilborough, & 3 Leen Valley)
- **25 Over 50's** Supported into employment (12 Aspley, 10 Bilborough, & 3 Leen Valley)
- **3 Regular** work clubs established in (1 Aspley, 1 Bilborough, & 1 Leen Valley)
- **15** work placements created (7 Aspley, 5 Bilborough, & 3 Leen Valley)
- **19** volunteering programmes created (9 Aspley, 6 Bilborough, & 3 Leen Valley)
- **75** Qualifications achieved at **Level 2** or above
- **3 Regular** neighbourhood engagement activities hosted (1 Aspley, 1 Bilborough, & 1 Leen Valley)
