ASPLEY WARD

- 32 business have been checked to ensure that they have valid trade waste licences (2)

- Works in default were carried out on an untidy garden on Helston Drive

- A resident on Ambleside Road and Ainsdale Crescent were issued with notices under the prevention of Destruction by Pests Act requiring them to tidy up their gardens which they did.
- A four year suspended possession order was obtained against a tenant on Woodfield Road following a cannabis cultivation being found on their premises.

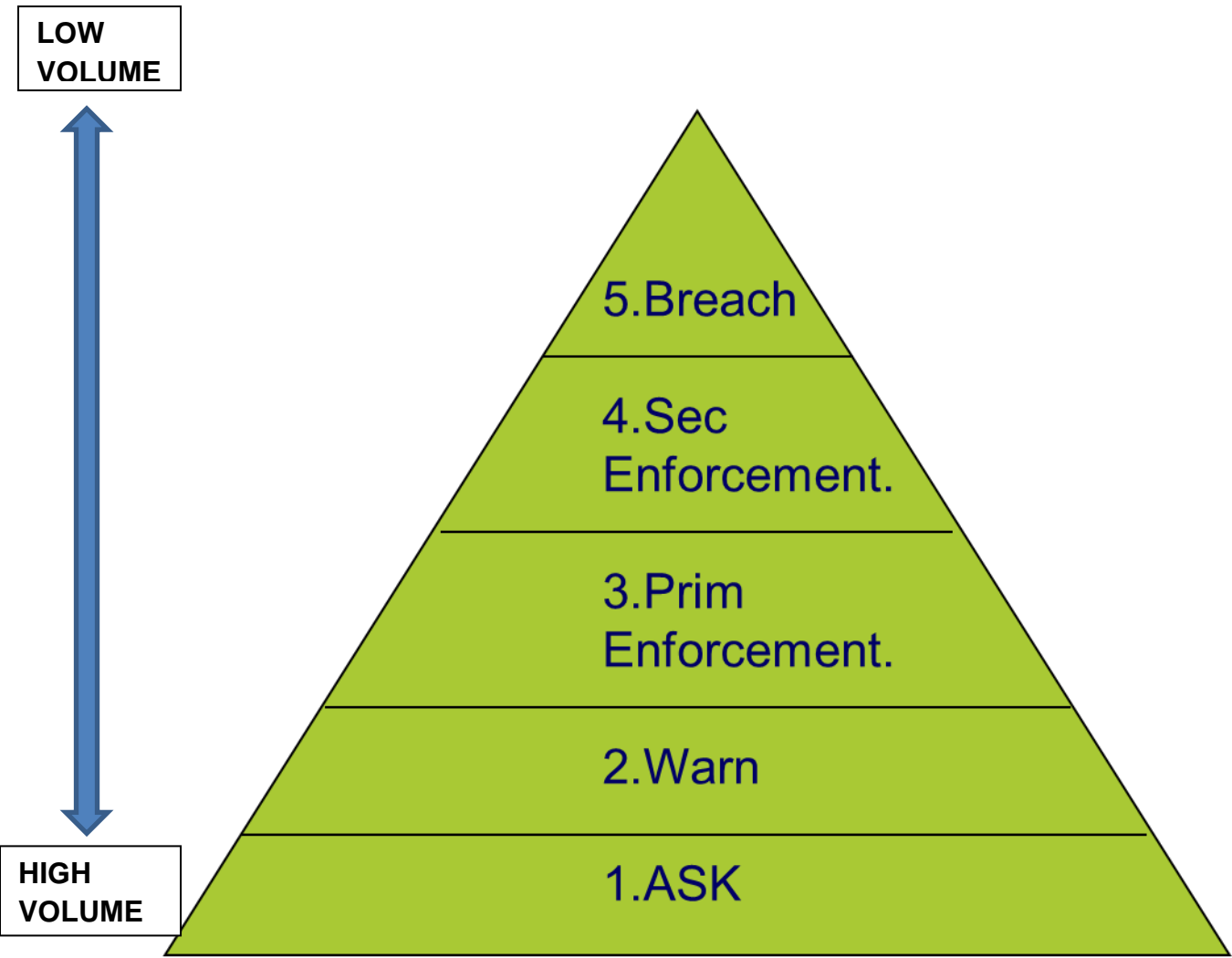

- CPOs to continue to work closely with City Services and Nottingham City Homes staff and carry out public realm inspections together.
- Embed the 5 stage model and People, Places, Premises across all the enforcement services.
- Deliver enforcement within the new ASB legislative requirements
- Maintain current levels of performance.
