1. REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS

Several parks and open spaces in the Mapperley Ward have capital funding allocated to them, some of which is no longer required now that development projects have been completed.

2. BACKGROUND (INCLUDING OUTCOMES OF CONSULTATION)

At Sycamore Park, £5,180 is remaining following the construction of the multi-use games area on site, woodland works and other small scale improvements.

At Mickleborough Railway Cutting, £9,820 is remaining following the re-distribution of the other £11,000 to works at Boynton Drive and Astley Drive play areas.

It is proposed to reallocate this funding as follows, to deliver much needed improvements at other sites:
