 Cobden Chambers is a new, exciting development in Nottingham's Creative Quarter, designed to promote, encourage and support the very best in contemporary craft and design in Nottingham, the East Midlands and beyond. Comprised around a large, central sun-trap (or rain shelter depending on the weather) of a courtyard, the Chambers is made up of The Terraces, Cobden Place, and the Bodega.

The Vision for The Terraces

The Terraces is a beautiful Victorian building, housing up to 10 individual units, each of which can be used for retail space, as workshops, as studios, or a combination of all three.
