




Introduction

- Activities available from children aged 5 to 18






Employment & Skills Area Partnership (ESAP)

Employment & Skills Area Partnership (ESAP)

What has been achieved:

- Held 2 Jobs & Opportunity Fairs (Riverside & Southglade)
- Providers had representatives every day for 2 weeks in Bulwell Job Centre
- Improved communication in the area between providers enabling all opportunities to be promoted
- Provided a forum for local organisations to promote themselves (example Travel Right can provide free transport to job seekers
 - Nottingham Jobs Hub have engaged with new employers as a result of feedback from local colleagues and cllrs
 - Improved collaboration between DWP and local organisations

There is now a forum which can lead and develop opportunities for local people, this will only improve our strategic view of moving forward by being better informed of local needs and an ability to react quickly.

Job Entry Rate (based on leavers) 63%, of those 70% sustain at 6 months

Bulwell Forest

Job Entry Rate (based on leavers) 58%, of those 67% sustain at 6 months
