1	Capital Programme & major works	Grander designs Kersall Court, Bulwell – starting in January with completion due for end of May 2017. Chatham Court, Bulwell - due financial year 2017/18. Springhead and Holwood Courts Sprinkler installation continues at the courts with wirk antic pated to be completed by the end of September. Stock condition surveys continue across the city focussing on those where we have not been able to gain access previously. The surveys are also collecting energy performance information on the properties. Home improvement works in the form of new kitchens and bathrooms continue across the city as well as electrical rewires and roof replacements	Information

2	Area Regeneration and Environmental Issues	Bulwell Norwich Gardens –Phase 5 of this project is underway at the time of writing this report and will be complete at time of Area Committee. NCH will carry out a satisfaction survey when the work is complete to capture tenant's views of the works. The works across phases 1-4 have always been very well received and had a positive impact on tenant's quality of life. We hope to continue the major woks across this part of Bulwell due to the success of what we have already delivered.	Information
		Duchess Gardens- We carried out a consultation event early March to discuss external improvements and this was very well received by the residents of this estate. We are now planning on delivering a second phase of the works to a further 5 properties and the funding for this has been requested at this area committee. We will then evaluate the success of this project and consider more works over the coming years.	
		Courtleet Way – NCH have plans to carry out major fencing improvements to this part of Bulwell and have selected the first 20 properties to benefit from the works. We are asking for funding to be approved at this area committee from the Ward Environmental Budget and then we will programme the works in across the year.	
		New build Ragdale Road - construction has started by Robert Woodhead, completion is due autumn 2017.	
		Bulwell Forest NCH are installing a pocket park at the Colston Road flats to create a natural play area for the young people living in a particular block. Work will start on this project May/June 2017. We will look at further improvements across the site as there is other work that has been identified by Ward Cllrs and Housing Teams. We will draw up a plan for Bulwell Forest in a bid to take some schemes to September's area committee.
