Dear Mr Kasas

Re Nottingham City Council (Arleston Drive areas, Wollaton, Nottingham) Prohibitions and Restrictions of Waiting, Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (TMP 7269)

We, the undersigned, write as the residents of Deer Park, Wollaton (NG8 2NX) to raise our objections to the above proposed restricted parking scheme. We have had sight of your letter dated 29th August 2018 to local residents and attached plan. We are aware that there are significant problems with parking around the Fernwood schools which is causing a dangerous situation for our children to which we want to see a safe and practical resolution. We appreciate that you are attempting to resolve this but write to you to consider the impact on our road if the proposed restrictions come into effect. We request that this letter is considered as part of your consultation and for confirmation that this has been done.

We write to raise our concerns as to the inevitable negative impact the proposed restrictions will have on our road if they come into fruition. It will be inevitable that the large volume of the displaced traffic will park or attempt to park on our road as it is the closest road not affected by the scheme.

No doubt you are aware that Deer Park is a fairly narrow road with no road markings or pavements which means that it is far less equipped to cope with the large volume of traffic than its surrounding streets. It would not allow safe, simultaneous parking on both sides of the road without prohibiting access for emergency vehicles or refuge collections.

The lack of pavements means that excessive parking will quickly become dangerous and likely to cause damage to the grass verges.

Furthermore, there is insufficient space for a number of vehicles to safely turn around concurrently and so the increased traffic will quickly mean that the road will become gridlocked.

We do not wish to move to visitor parking permits or road markings as we feel that there is insufficient room for this to be workable.

We await hearing from you that our objections have been duly considered within the consultation and the outcome of the same, in due course.
