PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2016

(ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014, CHAPTER 2 SECTION 59 – 75)

- Nottingham City Council, being satisfied on reasonable grounds that the activities prohibited by Articles 4 – 6 and Articles 7.1 of this Order in the Restricted Area:
 - have had or are likely to have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality, or
 - that it is likely that these activities will be carried out within that area and have such an effect, and
 - that the effect, or likely effect, of these activities is, or is likely to be, of a persistent or continuing nature, and
 - · that these activities are unreasonable and
 - justify the restrictions imposed by this Order

HEREBY makes the following Order

2. In this Order:



 Throwing or using any device to propel or discharge any object which is liable to cause injury to any other person or damage to property or street furniture in the Restricted Area Intentionally or recklessly disturbing any inhabitant, by pulling or ringing any door bell, or knocking at any door or window within the Restricted Area without valid excuse Leaning against, climbing on, climbing in or in any way interfering with any Motor Vehicle in the Restricted Area without the permission of the owner of the said Motor Vehicle Spitting in, onto or from the Restricted Area save where done within a handkerchief, tissue, bin, spittoon, or other similar receptacle for the
purpose of proper disposal. has the meaning given by section 136(1) of the Road
Traffic Regulation Act 1984
the plan attached to this Order
means the land designated in the Schedule to this Order
Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014
Includes but is not limited to:
 Threats made to un-associated members of the public or to others within the Prohibited Group Displays any writing, sign or other visible representation which is threatening or abusive Persistently shouting abuse or obscenities towards un-associated members of the public or to others within the Prohibited Group

3. This Order comes into force on 1 February 2016 and remains in force for a period of three years from that date.

Prohibitions:

- 4. No person shall play Ball Games in the Restricted Area.
- 5. No person shall spit in, onto or from the Restricted Area.
- 6. No person shall climb on any wall or fence in the Restricted Area, or any tree, or any barrier, railing, post or other Structure within the Restricted Area.



- 7.1 Groups of two or more persons are prohibited in the Restricted Area where one or more of the said group causes harassment, alarm or distress to any other person in the Restricted Area by continued:
 - (a) use of Threatening or abusive words or behaviour; or
 - (b) Disorderly behaviour.
- 7.2 For the purposes of Article 7.1 such behaviour is continued where an Authorised Person has:
 - (a) Informed them that if the behaviour continues that they will be deemed to constitute a Prohibited Group and will commit an offence, and
 - (b) asked the relevant person(s) in the group to desist from such behaviour but they have refrained from doing so.

Offence:

- 8 A person who fails without reasonable excuse to comply with a requirement imposed on him under Article 4, Article 5 or Article 6 of this Order commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
- 9 A person who without reasonable excuse is a member of a Prohibited Group commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
- 10 A person does not commit an offence under Article 5 where the spitting is done within a handkerchief, tissue, bin, spittoon, or other similar receptacle for the purpose of proper disposal.
- 11 A person does not commit an offence under this Order by failing to comply with a requirement that the Authority did not have power to include in the Order.

SCHEDULE

This Order applies to all land outlined in red on the Plan that is open to the air and to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access (without or without payment). For the purposes of this Schedule land which is covered is to be treated as land which is "open to the air" if it is open to the air on at least one side.
