Where young people who live in Area 2 access youth provision from April 2008 to February 2009

Summary

The total number of young people accessing youth service support during this period is 953.

Profile of users:

- 59% are male and 41% are female
- 45% live in Basford Ward, and 55% in Bestwood Ward.
- 26% of the 13-19 population in Basford and 32.8% of the 13-19 population in Bestwood.accessed youth provision in the period
- 68% are White, and 32% from BME communities
- The majority of services users are between 13-16 years of age
- 6% have a disability

Profile of services accessed:

- 65.6% use services other than that of the Area 2 youth team, most of which takes place outside Area 2:
 - o 31.7% (303) access adventure projects
 - o 17.6% (168) access other area teams (with Area 1, 3 and 4 being the highest)
 - o 11.2% (107) access grant aided projects
 - o 4% (47) access city-wide support focused projects
