A simplified partnership and Council communication structure.

Reduced number of theme partnerships.

The role of Neighbourhood Nottingham to be shared across all of the partnerships and VCS engagement is not contained only in the neighbourhood partnership.

It anticipates that the role of the area committees and potentially local area forums will be reviewed (currently under discussion in the Council)

Based on trust, communication and flexibility.
re-confirms the Nottingham Plan to 2020 as the
strategic plan for Nottingham.

The ON Board is strategic in a statutory
