## REPORT OF THE LEADER

### APPOINTMENT OF HONORARY ALDERMEN AND ALDERWOMEN OF NOTTINGHAM CITY COUNCIL

#### **1 SUMMARY**

The City Council may, by resolution passed by not less than two thirds of the members voting thereon at a meeting of the Council specially convened for the purpose, confer the title of Honorary Alderman/Alderwoman on persons who have, in the opinion of the Council, rendered eminent services to the Council whilst a Councillor.

It is proposed that the title of Honorary Alderman/Alderwoman should be conferred upon seven former Councillors in recognition of their eminent service as Councillors of the City Council.

#### **2 RECOMMENDATION**

IT IS RECOMMENDED by the Leader of the Council that the City Council pass the following resolution:

That in pursuance of section 249(1) of the Local Government Act 1972, the title of Honorary Alderman/Alderwoman be conferred upon the following former Councillors, who, in the opinion of the Council, have rendered eminent service to the City and its Council whilst serving as a Councillor:

#### **Martin Maurice Brandon-Bravo**
