29 GRANTING FREEDOM OF THE CITY TO THE 73RD ENGINEER REGIMENT (VOLUNTEERS) AND THE EAST MIDLANDS UNIVERSITIES AIR SQUADRON

The report of the Deputy Leader, as set out in the agenda, was submitted.

RESOLVED that on the motion of Councillor Chapman, seconded by Councillor Grocock, that this Council, by virtue of Section 249 of the Local Government Act 1972:

- (1) wishing to continue to recognise and foster the close association between the City and the regiment, hereby confers upon the 73rd Engineer Regiment (Volunteers), the Freedom of Entry to the City and thereby the right to march through the streets of the City on all ceremonial occasions;**
- (2) being aware of the grant of Freedom of Entry to RAF Newton in 1970, and wishing to continue to recognise and foster the close association between the City and the regiments, hereby extends the Freedom of Entry to the City to include the East Midlands Universities Air Squadron and thereby the right to march through the streets of the City on all ceremonial occasions.**
