PROCEDURE TO ADOPT A DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACE ORDER

The Council is required to undertake the following actions.

Before the Order is made:-

- (i) consult on the proposal with the Police, licensees within/on the boundaries of the proposed area and with owners and occupiers of land within the area to be covered by the proposed Order;
- (ii) notify the public by placing notice in the local press and inviting representations as to the proposed Order.

After the Order is made:-

- (iii) erect permanent signs to inform the public of the effect of the Order;
- (iv) undertake further public notification measures by placing notice in the local press confirming the making of the Order.

It is proposed that any representations received during the consultation procedure be reported to Council at the expiry of the consultation period.
