

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED CITY WIDE EXTENSION**  
**DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACE ORDER**  
**CONSULTATION**

1. Notice is hereby given that Nottingham City Council is considering whether to exercise its power to make a Designated Public Places Order in accordance with the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 and Local Authorities (Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Place) Regulations 2007 to control the drinking of alcohol in the following areas:

**SCHEDULE OF DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES**

All publicly accessible places including, but not limited to, all highways, squares, pedestrian areas, public conveniences, doorways, entrances and other open areas within the administrative boundary of Nottingham City Council delineated by a thick black line on the Plan placed on deposit as indicated in paragraph 6 below and detailed in the proposed Order, OTHER THAN within the areas identified as 'DPPO Areas' on the Plan and shaded dark blue, red, pink, sand, dark green and light green on the said Plan.

These areas would be designated for the purposes of the Order and are shown on the Plan placed on deposit as indicated in Paragraph 6 below.

2. The Order would operate by allowing a Police Officer or other accredited person, (including a Community Protection Officer), to require a person drinking alcohol in the designated area either to stop drinking and/or to surrender any container of alcohol in their possession. If that person failed to comply with the request, an offence would be committed. A Police Officer could then arrest that person. The Order would not make it an offence to consume alcohol in the designated area and the Police Officer or accredited person would have discretion as to whether to exercise these powers or not. These powers are not intended to be used for example where a family may be having a quiet picnic in the park and the parents may be consuming alcohol.
3. The Order would apply to highways and public areas as well as areas in private ownership to which members of the public have access. The Order would therefore cover open areas where drinkers could

otherwise take refuge such as car parks, doorways, forecourts and arcades.

4. The Order would not apply at any time to:-
  - a. Premises holding a Premises Licence or Club Premises Certificate authorising the sale or supply of alcohol under the Licensing Act 2003 (eg pubs, clubs, restaurants) and places within the curtilage of such premises (eg beer gardens, out door drinking areas)
  - b. Pavement Cafés or other places where the sale or consumption of alcohol is authorised by the City Council under Section 115E of the Highways Act 1980
  
5. Where:-
  - a. The City Council is the holder of a Premises Licence or Club Premises Certificate authorising the sale or supply of alcohol under the Licensing Act 2003 or the premises are occupied or managed on behalf of the City Council then the Order would not apply to those premises but only at those times when the Licence or Certificate was actually being used for the sale or supply of alcohol and for 30 minutes thereafter. Currently this would apply to the following places:-

**All city council owned, managed or run licensed premises within the proposed area delineated by a thick black line on the Plan attached to the Order other than within the areas identified as 'DPPO Areas'.**
  - b. Premises are the subject of a Temporary Event Notice authorising the sale or supply of alcohol under Part 5 of the Licensing Act 2003 then the Order would not apply to those premises but only for the period of the Temporary Event Notice and for 30 minutes thereafter.
