Mental Health in Nottingham

- Estimated 50,000 people in Nottingham have a mental illness (32k women, 18k men NEPHO 2008)
- Mental health and physical health interconnected
- Mental illness can result in shorter life expectancy



Commissioning Process

- 1. Needs assessment
- Plan and procure service user and stakeholder involvement; local need and national strategies
- Monitor and review all contracted services, including national and local comparisons



Mental Health – what we spend

Nottinghamshire Healthcare Trust - £53m

Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services, Adult mental health services, Mental Health Services for Older People, Specialised Services

High, medium and low secure - £17m

Private sector and NHS providers

Private and voluntary sector - £2.3m
