Mental Health in Nottingham

- Estimated 50,000 people in Nottingham have a mental illness (32k women, 18k men NEPHO 2008)
- Mental health and physical health interconnected
- Mental illness can result in shorter life expectancy

Commissioning Process

1. **Needs assessment**
2. **Plan and procure** – service user and stakeholder involvement; local need and national strategies
3. **Monitor and review** – all contracted services, including national and local comparisons
