## STREET TRADING – LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 1982 – PENNYFOOT STREET DESIGNATION

#### 1. **SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to consider the designation of Pennyfoot Street under the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 for the purpose of street trading.

#### 2. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

It is recommended that, pursuant to paragraph 2 of schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982:

- i) Pennyfoot Street together with all adjoining car parks and other areas to which the public have access to without payment, be designated as prohibited streets for the purposes of street trading with effect from 14<sup>th</sup> August 2002.
- ii) The Deputy Chief Executive and City Secretary be authorised to advertise the above resolution in accordance with paragraph 2 of schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982.

#### 3. BACKGROUND

Members may recall that at its meeting of 8<sup>th</sup> April 2002, the Licensing Committee indicated that it intended to designate Pennyfoot Street, together with all adjoining car parks and other areas to which the public have access without payment as prohibited for the purposes of street trading:

The steps required by paragraph 2 (3) of schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 have been complied with.

The Deputy Chief Executive and City Secretary advertised the Council's intentions, any objections received will be reported to the Committee.

#### 4. CITY TREASURER'S OBSERVATIONS

As there is currently no revenue generated from Street Trading in Pennyfoot Street, there is no financial impact on the City Council of prohibiting these activities.
