APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF ENTERTAINMENTS LICENCE Orange Tree, 38 Shakespeare Street, Nottingham

1.0 SUMMARY

1.1 This is an application to vary the entertainments licence by removing a special condition on the entertainments licence.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT the Committee determine the application having regard to an objection by Councillor Collins and to;
 - the City Council's Entertainment Licensing Policy No.1 'Matters that might present an adverse impact on the neighbourhood from the licensed activity have been assessed and suitable measures put in place to minimise or prevent the impact', and;
 - 'Matters that impact on local crime and disorder have been identified and suitable measures to the satisfaction of the Police have been established to minimise or prevent avoidable incidents' and;
 - 'Matters that might present an adverse impact on the neighbourhood from the licensed activity have been assessed and suitable measures put in place to minimise or prevent the impact' and;
 - 'That they have taken steps to ensure good order inside and outside the premises';
 - 'They can (or have put) in place such effective measures as given above to the satisfaction of the Council or Police.

3.0 BACKGROUND

3.1 The entertainments licence which has recently been transferred to Mr Philip Robinson is to provide music and dancing during the following hours:-

Mondays to Wednesdays - 10.30 am to midnight
Thursdays to Saturdays - 10.30 am to 12.30 am
Sundays - noon to 10.30 pm

3.2 The licence also has a special condition as follows:-

No admission after 10.30 pm when the entertainments licence is in operation.

4.0 PROPOSALS

4.1 Mr Robinson has applied to remove the special condition thereby allowing entry time after 10.30 pm.

- 4.3 Ward Councillors have been consulted and an objection has been received from Councillor Collins shown at Appendix 1.
- 4.4 The location of the premises is shown on the attached map and the applicant and Councillor Collins have been invited to attend.


