RESOLVED that the minutes of the last meeting held on 18 October 2004, copies of which had been circulated, be confirmed and signed by the Chair.

43 APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF ENTERTAINMENTS LICENCE - ISIS/SENORITAS, REDFIELD WAY

Further to minute 37 dated 7 October 2004, consideration was given to a report of the Corporate Director of City Development, copies of which had been circulated. Consideration was also given to a letter from the applicant and a document entitled 'Operational Guidelines - 1 September 2004'.

The applicant, Mr J Eftekhari, accepted the Committee's invitation to attend the meeting. Mr T Coulson, Service Manager (Food and Licensing), City Development Department, presented the report.

Mr Eftekhari and Mr Coulson, having made their submissions and been available for questioning, withdrew from the meeting during the committee's deliberations.

In reaching its decision, the Committee had regard to:-

- (a) the legislative framework and City Council's licensing policy No. 1 and conditions for entertainment licences;
- (b) duties imposed on the Council by Section 17 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 and the Human Rights Act 1998;
- (c) submissions by Mr Eftekhari regarding the application;
- (d) comments of the Corporate Director of City Development regarding the application at the meeting and those contained in the report.

RESOLVED

- (1) **that the application to vary the Public Entertainments Licence, for the premises known as 'Isis/Senoritas', be granted so as to vary the operational hours of Senoritas to permit opening as follows:-**

Mondays to Wednesdays	Noon to 2 am
Thursdays	Noon to 3 am
Fridays and Saturdays	Noon to 4 am
Sundays	Noon to 2 am
Sundays preceding bank holidays (Except Easter)	Noon to 2 am

- (2) **that special licence condition no. 3 prohibiting the provision of public entertainments beyond the hours permitted for the sale of alcohol, be removed;**
- (3) **that the Corporate Director of City Development be given delegated authority to revise the conditions of the licence to reflect the activities permitted and delete those conditions which had been duplicated;**
- (4) **that the Operational Guidelines approved by the Committee for the purposes of the Special Conditions be those dated 1 September 2004 save that page 2 shall be replaced by page 2 as submitted by the applicants letter dated 15 October 2004.**
