- Current pay formula, agreed in 1977, is now obsolete due to an increased number of tasks undertaken by fire fighters such as water rescue, community initiatives, ice rescue and chemical incidents;
- A need for parity for Control Room staff and retained fire fighters;
- Changes in the role of Control Room staff since 1977 agreement.

The Chairman thanked the fire fighters in the public gallery for their professionalism during the meeting.
