8.1 **LSPs**

Community Safety Strategy Group to be set up for avoidable injuries in City.

CFO reported that Policy Officer had been appointed on a fixed term (2 years) contract and he will form part of multi-agency team working that will come together in September.

Chair reported that he had written to John Collins reference the performance award grant and as yet had received no reply.

4. 7. PAY VERIFICATION UPDATE

The Phase 2 had been received from Audit Commission and a response will be made. Chief advised that the report had been moderated down at the moderation stage and it appeared that we are not getting recognition even though it appears that we are ahead of others in a lot of issues. Chair also to respond to the report.

5. FIRE & RESCUE NATIONAL FRAMEWORK

This document has now been published and is in force. The intention of the document is to set priorities and objectives for the Service with the aim of promoting public safety and the economy, efficiency and effectiveness of Fire Authorities and their functions. This is not a guidance document but a bible for operating procedures. Cllr Charlesworth said the implications of non-compliance needs to be made clear to Members. Members will receive own copy of the document when they are received from the ODPM. A full paper will be presented to the CFA at its September meeting.

6. THE FIRE & RESCUE SERVICES ACT 2004

The Act has now gone through Parliament and received Royal Assent on 22 July 2004. A full paper will be presented to CFA meeting in September. Due to its size copies of the Act will not be circulated but the document is available to view on the Intranet. It should be noted that the Secretary of State now has powers under the Act to intervene if he considers a Fire & Rescue Authority is failing, or likely to fail, to act in accordance with the National Framework.

7. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

7.1 Best Value Performance Indicators

CFO reported that a circular had been received from the ODPM requesting feedback of a suite of fire BVPIs.

7.2 Community Safety

SDO Beale issued Councillors with feedback on how community safety was doing in their areas.

7.3 **IRMP2**

CFO said a longer term vision was being considered for the Fire Authority. This would include a longer term vision of how the

Service would improve its relationship with its communities. One concept that would be developed would be that where a station was well placed it would lend itself to being developed for community bases and where not so well appointed a purpose facility would be sourced that was within the community itself. He described this as the "garage and shop" concept. The Handsworth visit had gone well and had helped identify that the concept there was not suitable for Nottinghamshire. It was felt that this alternative strategy would better serve our communities.
