58 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Councillor Griggs (on City Council business) and from Councillors Butler and Davidson.

59 MINUTES

RESOLVED that the minutes of the last meeting held on 9 September 2005, copies of which had been circulated, be confirmed and signed by the Chair.

60 DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS

No declarations of interests were made.

61 CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Chair reported that he had continued to visit Fire Stations and that Jim Fitzpatrick MP (Parliamentary Under Secretary of State) had visited St Mary's School, New Basford and had witnessed a Community Safety Officers' presentation of the Risk Watch module of the Community Safety Plan.

62 REGIONAL MANAGEMENT BOARD

Consideration was given to a report of the Chief Fire Officer and minutes of the meeting of the Regional Management Board held on 8 September 2005, copies of which had been circulated.

RESOLVED

63 TECHNICAL ADVISORY PANEL OUTCOME

Consideration was given to a report of the Chief Fire Officer and circular NJC/11/05 from the National Joint Council for Local Authority Fire and Rescue Services which included the recommendations of the Technical Advisory Panel, copies of which had been circulated.

RESOLVED that the report be noted.

64 <u>CO-RESPONDER UPDATE</u>

Further to minute 53 dated 22 October 2004, consideration was given to a report of the Chief Fire Officer which informed members of the measures taken to support the implementation of the pilot co-responder scheme and the reaction of the Fire Brigades Union, copies of which had been circulated.

RESOLVED

(1) that the report be noted and the implementation of the co-responding pilot scheme be endorsed;

(2) that a partial performance reduction by a level of 10% of employees' salary for refusal to deliver co-responding to the community during the industrial action which commenced on 3 October 2005, be endorsed.

Councillors Henshaw, Rigby and Stephenson requested that their abstention from voting on this item be recorded.
