JOINT REPORT OF THE CHAIR AND THE CHIEF FIRE OFFICER

FIRE AUTHORITY COMMITTEE ALLOCATIONS (GOVERNANCE)

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

The purpose of this report is to present to Members the Committee Allocations following the adoption of the new Committee Structure.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 In previous publications Her Majesty's Government has presented clear objectives and expectations in terms of leadership and priorities associated with elected Members and their role in public services.
- 2.2 The Fire & Rescue Service is assessed within the context of Leadership and Governance through the Comprehensive Performance Assessment (CPA) process. The CPA of Nottinghamshire and City of Nottingham Fire & Rescue Authority resulted in the Authority taking steps to improve its Governance arrangements through a fundamental review of its Committee Structures and process.

3. REPORT

- 3.1 Following a report on 3 June 2005 regarding the Governance of Nottinghamshire and City of Nottingham Fire & Rescue Authority, a working group was convened to establish a new committee framework which would revise the existing structure and better prepare the Authority for further scrutiny, not least through the CPA process.
- 3.2 Following a series of meetings and reports to subsequent Fire Authority meetings a revised Governance Structure was approved at the meeting of 21 October 2005.
- 3.3 This structure agreed committees, committee relationships, proportionality and terms of reference for each of the Committees. It also identified the relationship with Officers and presented an outline meeting schedule.
- 3.4 Following the formal adoption of this structure the next step was to agree and endorse which Fire & Rescue Authority Members would sit on which committee.

4. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The next part of the revised Governance arrangements is to convene the independent panel to review Members' Allowances, in light of the revised Committee structures. The outcomes of this will be presented to Members at the next meeting of the Fire & Rescue Authority.

5. PERSONNEL IMPLICATIONS

As identified in previous reports relating to the revised Governance arrangements, additional administrative support will be required. Recruitment of the post will be subject to the usual protocols ensuring fairness and equality.

6. EQUALITY IMPACT ASSESSMENT

An initial impact assessment has not been completed at this stage. A full impact assessment will be completed prior to implementation.

7. RISK MANAGEMENT IMPLICATIONS

Failure to have in place a robust and effective Governance Framework leaves the Fire & Rescue Authority vulnerable in respect of the objectives it has set and with regard to future CPA scrutiny. This could ultimately result in ministerial intervention.

8. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

That the Fire & Rescue Authority, having given approval to the revised Governance Structure, allocate Members to committees in anticipation of the commencement of the new Governance Framework.
