EXTERNAL AUDIT AND INSPECTION PLAN 2007/8

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

There are no direct financial implications of this report beyond the audit fees of £54,255. This represents a small increase on the fee for 2006/7 of £52,874. These fees are already included with the Authority's revenue budgets.
