18 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Cooper, Foster, Holt and James.

19 MINUTES

Subject to the following amendments to Appendix 1, Committee Membership, the minutes of the last meeting held on 1 June 2007, copies of which had been circulated, be signed and confirmed by the Chair:-

20 DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS

21 CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Chair reported that the recent flooding in the region had resulted in an unprecedented workload for the Service. Within a 24 hour period, 25-26 June 2007, 500 calls relating to flooding were received at the Control Centre, 150 different flooding incidents were attended by crews, with 124 individual and group rescues from the flood water. Nottinghamshire also assisted other Fire and Rescue Services within the region, mainly Lincolnshire. Water rescue equipment and skills had proved invaluable.

The Chair requested that Control Centre and Operational staff receive a letter of thanks acknowledging the effective execution of their additional workload under exceptionally challenging circumstances.

The Chair had attended a meeting of the Local Government Association (LGA) in London and had been asked to sign authorisation to progress the establishment of the Regional Control Centre.
