REPORT OF THE CHIEF FIRE OFFICER

LAND AND BUILDINGS UPDATE

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

To inform Members of the progress of current programme projects and of new developments in respect of the acquisition / disposal / construction / refurbishment of buildings and land.

2. BACKGROUND

Members will be aware that the Authority has an extensive Capital Programme related to property which it has maintained over a number of years. This programme is divided up into a number of key areas. This report sets out under each of those key areas the progress and proposals to date.

3. REPORT

3.1 <u>Major Projects</u>

3.1.1 Hassocks Lane: New Community Fire Station

The new fire station, anticipated to go operational in Spring 2008, will replace two conventional, outdated fire stations (at Beeston and Dunkirk) with a modern, flexible Community Fire Station which will provide a large garaging facility for New Dimension, fleet and additional administration / conference / training facilities. Planning consent for this project was granted in June. An internal project team has been convened to provide a detailed brief and liaise with the (external) design team, which is being recruited via competitive tenders - invitations have been issued to the County Council and private consultants.

3.1.2 Community Safety Offices

The Service has been unable to satisfactorily accommodate the Community Safety Team within its existing building stock and has therefore been seeking alternative premises to purchase or rent. A suitable building has been found in a former medical centre at 571 Farnborough Road, Clifton. The Authority's offer has been accepted and the purchase is currently being processed by our legal advisors, Browne Jacobson. Some internal alterations will be necessary before the premises can be occupied, so a moving date for Community Safety is not known at the time of writing.

3.1.3 Central Fire Station

The existing fire station in Shakespeare Street is unsuitable in design and condition for modern purposes and could be located more appropriately for both community and emergency response purposes. The Fire Service, Police and City Council have been holding joint discussions for several months on the potential for the whole Guildhall site, and these are still ongoing. A number of expressions of interest have already been received from potential developers.

3.1.4 Fire Service Headquarters New Entrance Block

The current main entrance to headquarters is inaccessible to some disabled visitors, therefore a new entrance block is to be built onto the dining room frontage which will also release / create additional office and conference facilities Planning consent was granted in July and a project team has been convened to carry the design and construction forward. Site works are expected to commence in October 2006 and be completed in June 2007.

3.2 Minor Works

A schedule of minor works projects for 2006/07 is attached as Appendix A to this report.

3.3 Miscellaneous Projects

3.3.1 Disability Discrimination Act (DDA) Programme

The majority of essential / urgent improvements recommended by the DDA consultant have been completed and the remainder will be undertaken in 2006/07 within the wider minor works projects identified in Section 3.2 above. A number of desirable but non-essential improvements – usually on retained stations – will be addressed as and when other works are required on the particular premises.

3.3.2 Shift Change

The introduction of Shift Change in January 2007 will, inter alia, entail the removal of dormitory facilities from wholetime stations and create opportunities for the better configuration of premises in alignment with current policies and strategic planning. Some short term changes, to benefit from the opportunities arising, will be planned over the coming weeks, but permanent alterations will require a more holistic approach and are not expected to be introduced before 2007/08.

3.3.3 Condition Surveys

A programme of (quinquennial) structural surveys of all premises will be commissioned this year, and the reports will contribute to the holistic planning referred to in 3.3.2 above.

3.3.4 Station Signage

Replacement of the outdated exterior signage on stations can commence this year now that the new corporate branding is being finalised.

3.4 Projects Completed in 2006/07

3.4.1 Harworth Fire Station

The new station was completed on 23 June 2006 and officially opened by the Chair of the Fire & Rescue Authority on 18 July 2006.

3.4.2 <u>Service Development Centre Shower Block</u>

A second shower block has been built at the Service Development Centre as part of the equalities programme to improve facilities for female employees. The construction works were completed in July 2006.

All projects will be contained within the capital and revenue budgets already agreed

5. PERSONNEL IMPLICATIONS

There are no personnel implications arising from this report.

6. EQUALITY IMPACT ASSESSMENT
