An apology for absence was received from Councillor Pettengell.

8 <u>DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS</u>

No declarations of interests were made.

9 MINUTES

RESOLVED that the minutes of the last meeting held on 30 July 2010, copies of which had been circulated, be confirmed and signed by the Chair.

10 JOINT ICT PROVISION

Consideration was given to a report of the Chief Fire Officer, copies of which had been circulated, on a current project by Leicestershire, Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire Fire and Rescue Services to implement a joint ICT provision.

The Chief Fire Officer reported that the memorandum of understanding signed by the three Chief Fire Officers was to work towards a regional system with an implementation date of 1 April 2011, and not March 2011, as stated in the report.

An away day had been held the previous day involving all ICT staff from the three Fire Authorities to discuss what a new model of provision might look like and to look at innovative solutions.

RESOLVED that the Chief Fire Officer submit a further report to the next meeting giving additional information on the current work being undertaken to move towards a single ICT provision for Leicestershire, Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire Fire and Rescue Services.
