#### 14 MINUTES

RESOLVED that the minutes of the last meeting held on 11 July 2007, copies of which had been circulated, be confirmed and signed by the Chair presiding at the meeting.

#### 15 PRIVATE HIRE LICENCE FOR REWACO HS5 TRIKE

Consideration was given to a report of the Corporate Director of City Development, copies of which had been circulated, detailing an application for a private hire vehicle licence for a 'Rewaco' three wheeled vehicle.

The applicant, Mr R Hall, accepted the Committee's invitation to attend the meeting and presented his case.

Mr R Hall and Mr J Mortell, having made their submissions, withdrew from the meeting during the Committee's deliberations.

#### **RESOLVED**

- (1) that the Council's adopted specification for private hire vehicles be extended to include the Rewaco HS5 Trike and the Taxi Licensing Officer be given delegated power to devise the precise terms and requirements of that specification, but to include a requirement that seat belts be fitted for all passengers;
- (2) that, following the revisions to the specification, the Taxi Licensing Officer exercise his delegated power to consider this application and report back to this committee with details of the vehicle specification and any special conditions imposed on the licence;
- (3) that the licence fee for the vehicle be the same as licence fees for other private hire vehicles.
