Summary of issues (including benefits to citizens/service users):

The Department for Education (DfE) has directed all local authorities to amend their schemes for financing Schools to reflect particular deletions and inclusions of text. The Nottingham City Fair Funding Scheme has therefore been reviewed and updated to incorporate these changes.

In addition to the directed revisions, all references to the Council 'One World' system have been replaced with 'Finance' system, and Annexe A: The Schedule of Schools within the scope of the scheme has been updated to take account of schools amalgamating and converting to academies.

- 1.1 Proposed revisions are subject to consultation with every school maintained by the Local Authority (LA) before they are submitted for approval. These amendments and a draft revised scheme were provided to all schools on 3 September 2013 with an invitation for comments. No responses have been received.
- 1.2 The directed revisions are issued by the Secretary of State for Education and contain provisions that the LA scheme must include. Approval of the changes will update the Nottingham Scheme according to the DfE guidance. The School and Early Years Finance Regulations (2012) require that the scheme be published on a website accessible to the general public. The revised scheme will therefore be published on the Nottingham Schools extranet which is accessible to schools and governing bodies and on the Nottingham City Council public website.
