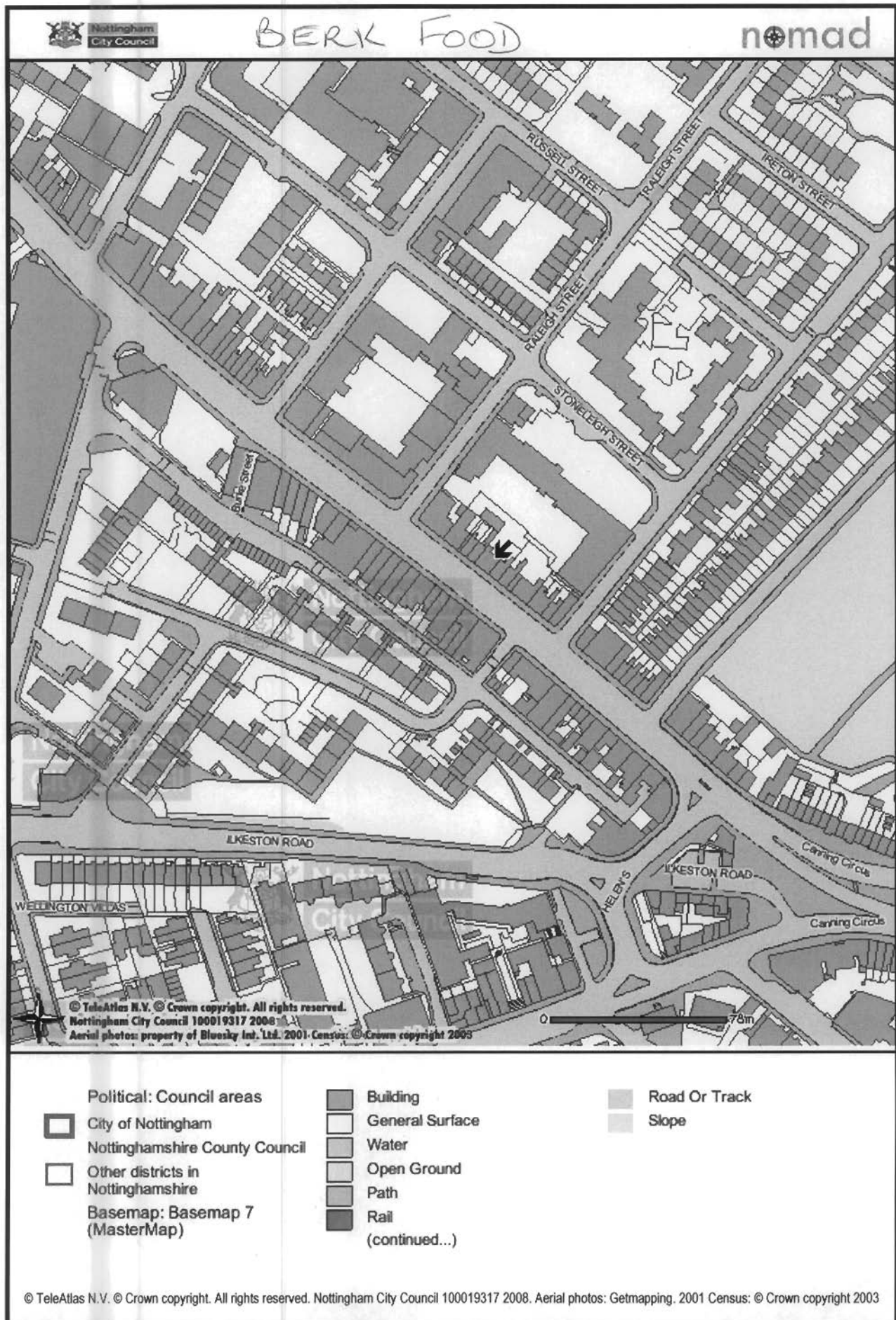

**c) Public safety**

Appropriate fire safety procedures are in place including fire extinguishers (H2O and CO2), internally illuminated fire exit signs, a smoke detector and emergency lighting.

All emergency exits will remain clearly marked at all times.

Emergency escape routes will be kept free of obstruction at all times.

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

All customers are asked to respect neighbours and leave quietly. Notices will clearly and prominently displayed reminding customers to leave quietly.

Trade refuse agreement to be arranged and maintained at all times.

**e) The protection of children from harm**

The licensee and staff will ask persons who appear to be under the age of 18 for photographic ID such as proof of age cards, the Connexions Card and Citizen Card, photographic driving licence or passport, an official identity card issued by HM Forces or by an EU country, bearing the photograph and date of birth of bearer


I am contacting you regarding the proposal for a license application for the retail outlet located at 52a - 54a Alfreton Road, Radford, Nottingham, NG7 3NN. The Independent Businesses Association (IBA), through its membership has been asked by local businesses and members of the community to register an objection against the proposed plans for the License Application of Mr. Ali Erdogan. The application raises many concerns and matters for your consideration. The IBA would strongly object, because if such an application were to be granted, the potential could have serious and negative impact upon the whole community. Alfreton Road has been in trading decline for many years, a primary reason why the district is situated within the heart of the NDC regeneration programme. Additional strain has been placed upon local shop owners, who have traded through difficult times, and whose livelihoods have been in the balance for many years. The existing businesses in the district in the "Licensed Trade" have a proven track-record of strong robust management, with long standing relationships with the diverse community their businesses support.

It is of great concern to the community that the mechanism of another like-for-like business, offering the same service to a community would offer more problems and add to social difficulties. Grave concern would be for a new licensed business, operating from in the area, possessing little, or no local history or knowledge, and who could put profit before the concerns of the community. Paramount is the consideration, that if this application were granted, apprehension would be created regarding the prevention of crime and disorder and public safety. The long established businesses already provide adequate service, with a local infrastructure of support with each other, and through their robust management style, are all able and prepared to eradicate risks to the public and local area. Additionally, existing licensed businesses through their collective knowledge of the "Alcohol Retail Industry" hold the well-being and social-cohesion with the "Status Quo" staying positive and constant. If this planning appeal were to be granted, it would seriously jeopardise the social structure within a multi-diverse community.

If this proposed application were to be gained, the likely outcome would seriously impact upon the livelihoods of many people, including the elderly and disadvantaged, with serious implications for the community as a whole. There is ample provision for alcohol, retail outlets providing this service in the area, sited within half a mile radius are "Licensed Food Retailers (9) and Public Houses (15)" the capacity for this trade has been surpassed, with obvious indicators shown in the closure of existing license establishments throughout the inner-city. This objection and request to you is not based on 'trading' and 'fair trade' but, if this application were agreed, there will be serious negative implications on the area with job losses affecting a large group of already disadvantaged people. Also, the implications to the diverse ethnic mix of shops would place additional strain on community cohesion, with shop closures adding to unemployment.

In conclusion, may I confirm that the Independent Business Association is **totally opposed** to the license application by Mr. Ali Erdogan. The Independent Business Association (IBA) represents over 2,000 businesses throughout greater Nottingham.


