Re: Letter in support of The Central Music Venue.

We, as residence of 801 The Litmus Building for the past three years, wish to write in support of the The Central Music Venue.

As we have been living opposite the venue for the past three years, we have experienced both Niche, who had regular cabaret events and The Central, with its regular music events.

We can confirm that on no occasion in the past three years have we experienced any anti-social noise levels from the venue.

We have also experienced, since the change to The Central, there are very low noise levels when people leave the venue at the end of the night.

However, we feel that if there are any issues of noise to be address within the area in regard to serious noise pollution, we would recommend that these are aimed at Oceana, - adjacent to The Central, but a further 300m from our building - who have regularly breached acceptable noise levels up to 4am in the morning, which has resulted in us having to sleep in the rear bedroom, as even with a juliette balcony and double glazing, noise levels in the early hours of the morning remain unacceptable.

Oceana have been contacted about these incidents which have even more impact in the summer months, where they leave the external doors open and the noise levels from the smoking area can be excessive, but have failed to implement any long term improvements.

We therefore feel that any claims against The Central regarding excessive noise levels are totally unfounded and feel that no further action should be taken against them.
