1 APPOINTMENT OF CHAIR

3 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Councillor Morley and Mr Oliver.

4 DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS

No declarations of interests were made.

5 MINUTES

RESOLVED that the minutes of the last meeting held on 5 March 2009, copies of which had been circulated, be confirmed and signed by the Chair.

6 WOLLATON AND LENTON ABBEY SUB-COMMITTEEE (Joint Acting Director of Local Communities and Deputy Chief Executive/Corporate Services Director)

Mrs Marshall contrasted the membership arrangements for the Sub-Committeewith that of the former Working Group structure, where Community Representatives had been regarded as members with voting rights. It was explained that this matter referred to the City Council's Financial Regulations, under which only elected members had the power to vote on expenditure, and that the role of Community Representatives on the Committee was not devalued in any way by this requirement.

8 FINANCIAL POSITION OF WOLLATON AND LENTON ABBEY AREA COMMITTEE

(Acting Director of Local Communities)

Consideration was given to a revised report of the Acting Director of Local Communities, copies of which had been circulated. The report presented to the individual Ward member Allocations for Wollaton East and Lenton Abbey and Wollaton West.

Referring to appendix 1 of the original report, Mr. Coulson commented on the following specific areas of expenditure:-

- Bramcote Lane Christmas lights: the approved amount of £3,500 for 2008/09 had not been fully spent and a more professional event would be staged in 2009;
- Allocations for local issues across the wards (3 x £1000): these applications were intended for small, one-off items;
- Lenton Abbey Funday: although the administering group had not been properly constituted the amount of £580 would be retained in the budget for the time being;
- Unspent elements of the following project areas would be brought back into the budget:-

- Consultation exercise to proposed works on Woodside Road and Arleston Drive (£2,900);
- Badger watch (Individual Member Allocations) (£250);
- Wollaton Library provision of furniture for Community Room (£100);
- CCTV cameras -provision at Farndon Green and redeployment of existing cameras (total £18,000).

Members referred to the allocation of ward member area budgets for 2010/11 contained in the original report, noting that wards such as Aspley, Bulwell, Bilborough, Arboretum, Leen Valley, St Ann's and Bridge, had all received enhanced allocations compared to other wards and based on their rankings against indices of multiple deprivation.

RESOLVED

- (1) that the financial position of the Area Committee, as at 31 March 2009, shown in Appendices 1-3 of the report and the individual ward member budget allocation of £10,000 in 2009/10, be noted;
- (2) that the additional allocations being made available to the top 5% of the most deprived wards in the City, based on Indices of Multiple Deprivation for 2007, as outlined in appendix 4 of the report be noted and the Area Manager be requested to confirm separately to elected members the formulae used to arrive at these enhanced allocations;

- (4) that decisions regarding funding for community-based actions within the area allocation budget be delegated to the Area Manager or, in their absence, the Acting Director of Local Communities, and that reports on such funding be provided by the Area Manager on a periodic basis.

9 NOTTINGHAM CITY HOMES LTD - PERFORMANCE APRIL 2008 - MARCH 2009

(Performance Review Manager, Nottingham City Homes Ltd)

Consideration was given to a generic report on the performance of Nottingham City Homes Ltd against a range of output measures identified in consultation with Area Housing Panels and to an abstract report showing matters of particular interest for this Committee's area.

The meeting noted that this Committee had been proactive in obtaining several breakdowns by individual Ward and Committee Area, making information contained in the abstract more relevant.

Mr. Pepper confirmed that areas covered in the report and the derived data were used to inform a series of themed discussions at Area Housing Panel meetings. He also explained the means by which City Council 'tenant inspectors' contributed to Estate Condition Ratings and the use of the VMS Repairs Survey Data to highlight issues for further action by the company.

The meeting identified the following areas of additional interest on which information could be provided for consideration by the Area Housing Panel:-

- How many units of social housing were in each of the two wards comprising this Committee's area and similar information for other areas across the City;
- The numbers and types of empty properties broken down by ward with reasons why empty and an indication of what could be done to improve take-up.

The meeting also commented on the usefulness of receiving regular updates.

RESOLVED

- (1) that the position be noted;
- (2) that, after consultation with the Area Manager and Area Housing Manager, Councillor Oldham as this Committee's representative on the Area Housing Panel be requested to provide updates on a quarterly basis on the progress of the Panel and activities which were of relevance to this Committee.

10 LANDSCAPE IMPROVEMENT TO CROWN ISLAND, NOTTINGHAM RING ROAD

(Acting Director of Local Communities)

Further to minute 65 dated 5 March 2009, the Committee considered details of the proposed planting scheme for the refurbishment of Crown Island.

The Committee noted that there was virtually no difference between the costs of carrying out the work on a Sunday (£4,217.18) rather than during the working week (£4,298.31).

In view of this, the Committee suggested that the work be undertaken mid-week, but at a time of least impact on traffic using the area, and that the Area Manager should consider approaching colleagues in the West Area regarding the possibility of funding refurbishment works to that part of the Crown Island site which lay within its area.
