## 1 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 Sited close to the Lenton Industrial Estate, the Unity Cricket Club was founded over 50 years ago to support local people to play cricket at an amateur level. Since its establishment the Club has produced cricketers that went on to play for Nottinghamshire and other Counties across the Country.
- 1.2 Many club activities are carried out by volunteers who give up their free time to help the youngsters, carry out repair and building works to the club facilities. The facilities are vandalised regularly and much of the funds the club raises go towards the necessary repairs. However, at present the club is looking to improve its facilities including improvements to security. Whilst the work will be carried out by tradesmen registered as volunteers with the club, £10,000 is needed to purchase materials.
- 1.3 Of the current 150 members about half of the young people who play cricket at Unity are students from Fernwood School which is the club's adopted school.
