1	Capital Programme & major works	Asbestos A planned programme to carry out management surveys of three storey buildings where there are asbestos-containing materials (ACM) around the City is being collated. The Management Survey aims to ensure that (1) nobody is harmed by the continuing presence of ACM in the premises or equipment (2) that the ACM remain in good condition (3) that nobody disturbs it accidentally. 		Damp and mould Surveys have increased in line with seasonal demand. There is an average eight day wait for a survey. Works should be completed within 90 days of the survey being passed to CRaM, however a backlog is building due to resource.	
		Woodlands flats Change of use to return eight areas back into flats at a cost of £115k each. The price and designs are with NCC to make a decision.	
		CCTV is to be installed at Ash and Willow View.	
		Pine View was due to be coming out of defect liability period at the end of December, but due to the issues we have had on this site, defect liability has been extended for three months with AXIS Elevators so that the reliability / availability can be improved before it is passed across to our incumbent provider.

		 Works to complete the installation of new intercom and public address systems across the Woodlands blocks are now complete with the exception of 2 citizen's that have not provided access to their home to complete the intercom. Colleagues from Tenancy and Estate Management are working with us to gain access to complete works. Final commissioning of the sprinklers will be completed before April; the sprinkler systems are already live and read to work, the commissioning is the final sign off by the design engineers. Kitchen and bathrooms (citywide) 169 completed to date via J Tomlinson 37 of which have been adaptations to bathrooms including installing level access showers or showers over bath. CRaM have replaced three bathrooms with 65 to complete by the end of the financial year Windows and Doors 303 doors have been completed by Nationwide citywide and 785 properties have received new windows citywide.
