	by the Council as asset owner, and recharged to Enviroenergy Ltd in full. It is proposed to fully test the market by running a
	procurement process rather than using the Council's existing Highways Framework.
Other Options Considered:	To not complete the works. This would result in Biocity no longer being supported by a district heating connection, and no heat supply,
	resulting in a loss of revenue to Enviroenergy Ltd and greater financial risk to the Council.
