21 FLIRTZ, 26A FRIARY CHAMBERS, FRIAR LANE, NG1 6DQ - APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF SEX ESTABLISHMENT LICENCE

The Committee considered a report of the Corporate Director of Communities regarding an application for the renewal of a Sex Establishment licence for the premises known as Flirtz.

Philip Thompson and Amanda Town, Alljay Leisure Limited, attended the meeting. They were represented by David Lucas, Fraser Browne Solicitors, who presented the application and summarised the professional expertise of the applicant company and its officers, and stated that they had been involved with these premises since December 2006.

Tony Charlesworth, City Licensing, reported receipt on 16 October 2014 of a letter objecting to the renewal of the licence. He stated that due to the deadline for representations being 18 September 2014, and the objections not being on Licensing Act grounds, this letter was not submitted to the Committee for consideration.

Following this, all parties then answered questions from members, following which the Committee considered its decision.
