Continue to Deliver Employment Support to those aged 18-29 through the Step into Work YEI Programme	The Bridges Community Trust have continued to support those seeking employment that are NEET (not in Employment, Education or Training) throughout this pandemic, although lockdown has reduced expected engagement numbers due to having to shut the office for large periods of time, all Employment Advisors have continued working remotely serving the 25+ clients currently on the YEI (Youth Employment Initiative) under Nottingham Jobs Step Into Work program. We are seeing these numbers pick up and are working closely with the DWP and Nottingham City Council Employment teams as well as exploring other referral pathways (Prince's Trust, NHS, ABG partners, Community Groups etc). Whilst they are not meeting previously set monthly targets, the employment contracts are deemed to be on track under the current circumstances. The Bridges Community Trust

- **Connected2**
We have secured funding for our 'Connected2' project aimed at upskilling the digitally poor. We have recruited 2 x Connectors who are in the process of putting the project in place. Working with Nottingham Jobs and Nottingham College, we aim to have a 12-week training program starting in early January (confirmation to follow) to provide basic computer and internet-based skills and where possible, provide equipment or internet access costs to those most in need. The Connectors are: Laura Crosby (Lead) and Suzette Cope.
- **National Lottery Community Fund**
We have secured funding for core costs until 31st March 2021 and are currently recruiting for 1 X part-time Office and Finance Manager and 1 X part-time Community Engagement and Impact Manager. Both roles can be found on Nottingham Jobs
