**NEXT STEPS ACCOMMODATION PROGRAMME GRANT DETERMINATION 2020-21  
[No. 31/5210]**

I am pleased to inform you that the Department is now able to issue a Grant Determination for the interim accommodation and support aspect of the Next Steps Accommodation Programme (NSAP) 2020-21 RDEL funding.

I enclose at Annex A a Determination made under section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003. Allocations can be seen at Annex B.

The grant is ring-fenced for 2020-21 and is to be used for Next Steps Accommodation Programme interventions only as set out in Annex C. Future awards of rough sleeping funding will be reduced to the extent that funding is not used in line with the ringfencing condition.

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**NEXT STEPS ACCOMMODATION PROGRAMME GRANT DETERMINATION 2020-21

The Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government (“the Secretary of State”) in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003 hereby makes the following determination:-

**Citation**

1) This determination may be cited as the Next Steps Accommodation Programme Grant Determination (2020-21) [No.31/5210]

**Purpose of the grant**

2) Local authorities in England have housed approximately 15,000 individuals in emergency accommodation since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic. The purpose of the grant is to ensure that this provision can continue for an appropriate length of time, individuals receive appropriate support while in this accommodation and planned transitions to longer-term accommodation take place where possible.

**Determination**

3) The Secretary of State determines that the grant be paid for 2020-21 to the following local authorities as shown in Annex B.

**Grant conditions**

4) Pursuant to section [31(3) and] 31(4) of the Local Government Act 2003, the Minister of State determines that the grant will be paid subject to the conditions in Annex C.

**Treasury consent**

5) Before making this determination in relation to local authorities in England, the Secretary of State obtained the consent of the Treasury.

## **ANNEX C – Grant Conditions**

1. (Ringfencing condition) This funding allocation (and any agreed refocussing of Rough Sleeping Initiative funding) must only be used to procure interim accommodation and immediate support as part of the Next Steps Accommodation Programme. You will have received a separate letter already stating the specific interventions you have been funded for and any grant conditions that are specific to your local authority.
2. Funding must be used to achieve move-on for those rough sleepers accommodated during the pandemic and a sustained reduction in rough sleeping in your local area.
3. You will agree to discuss and engage in communications on the NSAP programme where requested.
4. You will work with MHCLG analytical & policy teams for the national NSAP evaluation.
