

Safer Streets 2 Funding

Finance Comments

This decision requests approval to accept Home Office funding of £40,753 as allocated to the Nottinghamshire Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) for funding in Nottingham City. It also seeks approval to allocate the full amount of the funding to Resident Services in accordance with the grant conditions set out by the Home Office.

There is no requirement for ongoing funding for this project, and all costs and activity will need to be within the terms of the grant conditions and concluded by the end date of 21st March 2022 as this is a one off grant and no spend or activity may be carried forward. However the Home Office has indicated that if the Safer Streets Fund is successful, they may look into running it again in future.

The budget manager will need to put in place the appropriate monitoring and reporting processes in place to ensure adherence to the grant conditions, in order to avoid possible clawback of grant funding.

Also, ensuring adherence to all processes to meeting the requirements of this funding including but not limited to recruitment, purchasing and Capital processes.
